



Camper Code of Conduct 2020

This code is in effect from the 24th day of July, 2020.

PHASE 3 OF REOPENING

Campers,

Grangeways Inc. welcomes you! Please read this Code of Conduct (the Code) and review it with all family members. The rules in this Code must be followed to ensure we all stay safe and do not engage in activities that contravene any Provincial or Federal Government regulations and ensure we comply with all health regulations. It is important to remember that, ultimately, we are all in charge of our own health and safety. Please remember to bring a mask and gloves or hand sanitizer for the occasion that you will need it, regular hand washing is strongly encouraged.

This Code is over and above our normal Rules, which still apply. Strict enforcement of all rules will be in place for all registered names. Any camper, regardless of age who breaches this Code will be asked to leave the campground immediately.

If you have a fever or flu-type symptoms, please stay home. If you have tested positive for COVID-19, are a presumptive case, or have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive or is a presumptive case, we request that you do not attempt to enter the campground. Please remain at your residence until you have been cleared by your local health department and/or you have finished your self-isolation of 14 days.

If you are returning from travel from outside of the Province of Ontario, do not plan to visit the campground for a period of 14 days, please remain home.

At this time, we will be operating under the following rules. These rules may change as the Ontario or Federal Government amends legislation.

Visitors

Only people whose names are registered on the Licence of Occupation, Seasons Pass holders, or registered Overnight Campers are permitted in the campground. Daily visitors will still be restricted to immediate family only for seasonal campers, no visitors for overnight campers. Access will be permitted once they have signed and completed the Liability Waiver, and have submitted it to the office – they must be registered at least 24 hours in advance. The Liability Waiver is available for download on our website.

POOL – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

The pool will be open and operating under STRICT MONITORING. In addition to the regular posted Rules & Regulations, there will be additional measure to follow. The pool will be open, and available for use on a sign-up basis ONLY. It is important we monitor the people in and out of the pool at all times, as well as social distance at all times around the pool area or while swimming.

- **WEEKDAY SWIMMING:** Follow the arrows to approach the store window as you normally would, advise the office you want to go swimming, approach the sign in table located to the left of the pool and wait by the marked tape on the ground where the office staff will come sign you in. You will then be asked a series of questions prior to entry, and given a time allotment (should there be other bathers waiting). You will also be assigned a square to place your belongings/watch your children from.
- **WEEKEND SWIMMING:** Follow the arrows to approach the store window, continue to the pool sign-up table, wait by the designated markings and wait for instructions from the staff who is stationed by the pool. If the pool is busy, the time allotted to each person will be 15minutes.

- The occupancy will be limited to 10 of bathers at a time, no exceptions. Unless you are part of the same family, you must adhere to social distancing guidelines and maintain a minimum distance of 6ft apart at all times when in the pool. Any violations will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave the pool immediately.
- All bathers must use the outdoor shower provided to rinse off prior to entry, or shower in their own facilities prior to entry. Also, sanitize their hands prior to entering the pool deck.
- Please use the allotted squares provided for your personal items – do not hang your towels/clothing on the fence. You can bring your own chairs up to the pool, however once your 'swim slot' is up, please vacate the area to allow room for the next set of swimmers. NO GATHERINGS AROUND THE POOL AREA.
- **DO NOT ENTER THE POOL WITHOUT SIGNING IN WITH A STAFF MEMBER****

Office/Store

- We will continue to operate out of the side window from 10am-6pm for normal inquiries, please follow the signage that is in place and respect social distancing rules AT ALL TIMES.
- If you need to enter the office to make a purchase or complete paperwork, sanitize your hands prior to entry, ONE PERSON IN THE OFFICE AT A TIME. Please wait by the stop sign, and wait for the office employee to tell you it is safe to enter. **YOU MUST WEAR A MASK INSIDE THE OFFICE.**
- At this time, the office/store is selling Propane, Firewood, Ice and ECOETHIC (when supplies are available).

Laundry Room

The laundry room will be open from 10am-6pm. Use at your own risk. Please sanitize/wash your hands before and after each use to maintain clean hand hygiene. Maximum 2 people in the laundry room at a time, masks must be worn.

Common Areas - CLOSED

The following common areas are closed until further notice. All areas that are closed are indicated with a sign. If you are unsure whether something is closed or not, please contact the office for clarification.

- Public Bathrooms
- Fitness Centre
- Outdoor pool tables

Common Areas – OPEN FOR SAFE USE ONLY WITH YOUR OWN PERSONAL EQUIPMENT

The following common areas will be accessible for use with your own personal equipment. These areas will be open strictly for skill use and NO SCRIMMAGES/GAMES ALLOWED. Parents MUST accompany children to ensure social distancing rules are OBEYED AT ALL TIMES.

- Baseball diamond
- Ball Hockey Court
- Basketball Court
- Volleyball Court

Common Areas – OPEN FOR SAFE USE ONLY WITH SANITIZED RENTALS

The following common areas will be accessible for use with your own personal equipment, OR sanitized rentals provided by Grangeways Inc. Parents MUST accompany children to sign out equipment and to ensure social distancing rules are OBEYED AT ALL TIMES. See staff at office window for equipment sign-out instructions.

- Mini Putt

- Ping Pong
- Shuffleboard
- Horseshoes

Walking around Campground

At all times campers must obey social distancing rules as mandated by the Province of Ontario. Currently, you must stay a minimum of 2 meters or 6 feet away from other campers. There will be no gatherings in public areas or along the river banks.

Limit of People/Campers in an area

- **ON A CAMPSITE:** Maximum 30 people per site. We feel this is an appropriate number for the size of your lot to ensure everyone can stay 6 feet apart safely. **IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE ON YOUR CAMPSITE TO RESPECT THE SOCIAL DISTANCING GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS THAT ARE IN PLACE.**
- **INDOORS:** Indoor gathering limits at a maximum of 50 people – must wear a mask; Gathering limits are subject to physical distancing requirements.
- **OUTDOORS:** Outdoor gathering limits at a maximum of 100 people; Gathering limits are subject to physical distancing requirements.

Children and/or under the age of 16

We expect that all parents will ensure their children will obey the rules 24/7. If your children cannot follow these rules, please do not bring them to the campground at this time.

Events/Activities

Campfires

As an extra safety measure we are continuing to ask people to STOP STOCKING FIRE AT 1:30am and FIRES MUST BE OUT BY 2am. This is for everyone, seasonal and overnight campers and will reduce the temptation of having gatherings after hours.

Outdoor Staff

Please do not stop outside staff for maintenance requests. If you have requests please bring them to the office or email them and we will deal with them accordingly when able to do so. Please maintain 6 feet distance between you and all staff members at all times.

Respect of others and staff

All Customers, guests and staff are responsible for respecting the dignity and rights of everyone at the campground. Every person has a right to expect their time at the campground will be without any type of discrimination or harassment. We will not tolerate, ignore, or condone discrimination or harassment and we are committed to promoting respectful conduct, tolerance and diversity at all times.
