



Camper Code of Conduct 2021

This code is in effect from the 1st day of May, 2021 until the Stay-at-Home is lifted

Campers,

Grangeways Inc. welcomes you back! Please read this Code of Conduct (the Code) and review it with all family members. The rules in this Code must be followed to ensure we all stay safe and do not engage in activities that contravene any Provincial or Federal Government regulations and ensure we comply with all health regulations. It is important to remember that, ultimately, we are all in charge of our own health and safety. Please remember to bring a mask and gloves or hand sanitizer for the occasion that you will need it.

This Code is over and above our normal campground rules, which still apply. Strict enforcement of all rules will be in place for all registered names on your occupancy agreement. **Any camper, regardless of age who breaches this Code will be asked to leave the campground immediately and your Licence of Occupation will be cancelled immediately with no refunds.**

If you have a fever or flu-type symptoms, please stay home. If you have tested positive for COVID-19, are a presumptive case, or have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive or is a presumptive case, we request that you do not attempt to enter the campground. Please remain at your residence until you have been cleared by your local health department and/or you have finished your self-isolation of 14 days.

If you are returning from travel from outside of the Province of Ontario, do not plan to visit the campground for a period of 14 days, please remain home.

O. Reg. 265/21: Stay at Home Order Restrictions

Seasonal campers who have a full season contract are permitted to enter the campground with the following restrictions:

- You must stay for 14 consecutive days before leaving the premises for non-essential reasons.
- If you need to leave the campground for any non-essential reason, you cannot return to the campground for 14 days.
- All indoor and outdoor gatherings are **restricted to members of a single household only**.
- You are permitted to leave the campground for the following purposes: essential work, healthcare appointments, and essential goods & services.

There will be no overnight camping, no short-term stays, no dropping items off, and campers cannot go back and forth to their primary residence during the 14 day restriction. The only essential access permitted for less than 24hours during the stay-at-home order is trailer delivery, trailer removal, or trailer sale previously scheduled with the office.

This will remain in effect until the Provincial Stay at Home Order is lifted May 20th, 2021 (unless otherwise stated by the Government). Once the order is lifted, we will return to the colour coded system.

Operation during Stay-at-Home Order

At this time, we will be operating under the following rules. These rules may change as the Ontario or Federal Government amends legislation.

Visitors – NO VISITORS

Until further notice, only people whose names are listed on the License of Occupation living in your household will be permitted in Grangeways Inc. There will be no access to seasons pass holders, and no access for visitors until we move into lighter restrictions.

All Recreational Facilities & Common Areas - CLOSED

All recreational facilities and common areas will be closed until further notice, including playgrounds. If you are unsure whether something is closed or not, please contact the office for clarification.

Walking around Campground

At all times campers must obey social distancing rules as mandated by the Province of Ontario. Currently, you must stay 2 meters or 6 feet away from other campers.

Limit of People on a Campsite – ONLY YOUR HOUSEHOLD

Until such time as the Government of Ontario lifts the stay-at-home order, the only people permitted on your site are members of your household, listed on the 2021 Licence of Occupation. TO BE CLEAR: There is no “bubble”, no distanced gathering, and no loitering on the edge of sites. **IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO MONITOR THE PEOPLE ON YOUR CAMPSITE AND RESPECT THE GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS THAT ARE IN PLACE.**

Children and/or under the age of 16

We expect that all parents will ensure their children will be under their direct supervision and obey the rules 24/7. If your children cannot follow these rules, please do not bring them to the campground at this time.

Events/Activities

There will be no events or scheduled activities until the social distancing and social gathering restrictions from the government have been lifted.

Supplies

- Uxbridge can accommodate your purchases, you will be able to do your essential shopping locally.
- Please remember you should be limiting your essential purchases to Durham Region during your 2 week stay at Grangeways Inc.

Office/Store

- The office itself will be CLOSED.
- The office/store will ONLY be selling Firewood, Propane, and ECOETHIC (when supplies are available). Please place your order at least 24 hours in advance by emailing info@grangeways.com, and send payment via e-transfer or arrange to pay by tap at the office at scheduled pick-up time.
- No cash payments will be accepted at this time.
- We will NOT be selling supplies/candy/pop for the time being.

Outdoor Staff

Please do not stop outside staff for maintenance requests. If you have requests please email the office and we will deal with them accordingly when able to do so.

Respect of others and staff

All Customers, guests and staff are responsible for respecting the dignity and rights of everyone at the campground. Every person has a right to expect their time at the campground will be without any type of discrimination or harassment. We will not tolerate, ignore, or condone discrimination or harassment and we are committed to promoting respectful conduct, tolerance and diversity at all times.

By signing this Code of Conduct you agree that you and your family members have read and understood all the details, rules and regulations outlined above and will abide by them for the duration of the Government mandated stay-at-home order.
